What documents do I need to bring to find out if I qualify?

- **Identification**
 - **Candidate must be 16-21 years old**
 - Social Security Card
 - State / Government Issued ID card / Drivers License
 - School ID (Must be enrolled in school and the ID must have a photograph)
 - Birth Certificate (**must be 16-21 years old**)
- **Income**
 - **Public Assistance Records (Provide one of these)**
 - Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
 - formerly known as Food Stamps
 - Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF)
 - Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
 - Provide a current award letter including monthly issued amount
 - Unemployment Insurance (UI)
 - **Pay Stubs – Provide the most current pay stubs for household**
