- Identification
  - o Candidate must be 18-21 years old
    - Social Security Card
    - State / Government Issued ID card / Driver's License
- Income
  - Public Assistance Records (Provide one of these)
    - Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
      - formerly known as Food Stamps
    - Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF)
    - Supplemental Security Income (SSI)
      - Provide a current award letter including monthly issued amount
    - Unemployment Insurance (UI)
  - Pay Stubs Provide the most current pay stubs for household
